The Putney School seeks an hourly, part-time, temporary registered nurse to provide on-call nursing coverage at night (7:30 p.m. to 7:30 a.m.) via pager from Sunday to Thursday from June 23, 2019 to August 2, 2019 (Can potentially be split into two positions, Session I 6/23-7/12 and Session II 7/14 -8/2) This is a non-benefited position.

Essential Responsibilities:

- Responds to pages or phone calls from Summer Programs staff for medical consultation during oncall hours; any visits to campus while on call are compensated at \$40/hr
- Communicates with other Health Services nurses, Putney School and/or Summer Programs staff, and, as needed, parents
- Includes being present, if possible, for registrations from 11 am to 7 pm on Sunday, June 23 and July 14
- Includes being present for orientation to Health Services sometime in the third week of June (TBD) for approximately 3 hours

- School nursing, camp nursing, and/or pediatric experience preferred
