The Putney School is seeking a part-time **Ultimate Frisbee Coach** for the Spring Trimester of the 2025-26 School Year. Coaching athletics at The Putney School is more than just teaching high-school students to play a sport; inclusivity and community team building are core components of our athletics program.

About The Putney School: Putney is a progressive boarding school for about 200 hardworking and curious students in Putney, Vermont. Hands-on learning is embedded in the school's culture: a working dairy farm, expansive arts offerings, a robust work program, miles of wooded trails, and large solar arrays serve our curriculum. Employees are also part of an intentional residential experience that values belonging and community. We seek applicants who find joy in their work and help others realize how much fun authentic, student-centered learning can be. The school cultivates and sustains an educational community that values difference. Community members explore how they contribute to building a home at Putney where everyone, especially those from historically marginalized populations, can honor their individual racial, gender, ethnic, and socio-economic identities. Putney recognizes this is difficult, communal work, and the school supports all its employees in developing this critical skill set.

Responsibilities:

- Collaborate with co-coach to plan, organize, and conduct daily practice sessions, Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday from 3-4:30 pm, plus Wednesday from 2-3:30 pm, during the Spring Trimester.
- Coaching games at various times throughout the season.
- Encourage, motivate, and train students of all abilities and backgrounds in the fundamentals of Ultimate Frisbee and to develop game strategies, as well as teamwork, discipline, and good sportsmanship.
- Ensure that safety rules and regulations are understood and followed by all.

Qualifications:

- A strong background in Ultimate Frisbee and previous coaching experience are required.
- First aid/CPR/AED certification is required, as well as CDC Concussion Training.
- Prior experience working with teenagers preferred.
- Must possess a valid driver's license, successfully pass a criminal and sexual offender background check, and be authorized to work in the United States.

Pay begins at \$85 per practice session plus additional compensation for coaching games.
